🌸 What are the dates, destinations and ship info for this quilting cruise?

🌸 What are the costs involved to participate and how do I register?

We have a two-step registration – one for the Onboard Quilting Excursion™ handled by [The Quilt Rambler](#), Karen Overton and a second for the cruise stateroom reservation handled by our travel agent, Patti Roznovak with [Northcutt Travel Agency](#). You must make a reservation and a deposit with both ladies to secure your spot on the cruise.

🌸 What is An Onboard Quilting Excursion!™ and how much does it cost?

This is your ticket for all the quilting experiences and quilting activities onboard the cruise.

Step one of our registration! Your Onboard Quilting Excursion™ fee includes: Instructional fees for 3 full days of classes during the 3 days at sea from 9 am – 4 pm; a reserved spot in the ship's Conference Room/Classroom; use of our sewing machine for the full week (conference room/classroom is available almost 24/7 for your ultimate retreat experience); basic sewing needs such as thread, bobbins, irons and cutting stations; classroom support with experienced Bolts & Quarters staff members; a spiral bound pattern guide with two quilt projects designed by Karen & Brian, plus a bonus project, tips, and more – destined to be a keepsake; our official *Quilting with The Rambler and The Redneck* t-shirt and tote bag! And what's a quilting cruise party without a party! Our Welcome Aboard Party on our departure date will kick off our adventures! All included in your Onboard Quilting Excursion™ fee for only \$450 per quilter. 🌸 What are the projects, and do I have to choose between one teacher or the other?

The Conference Room/Classroom will be divided in half to form two classrooms. You will be assigned a sewing station that is your location for the duration of the week's Onboard Quilting Excursion™ activities. Day 1 of instruction will have Karen teaching in one room and Brian in the other. On Day 2 of instruction they will rotate ~ quilters will have full instructions for both projects without having to move! Day 3 of instruction is a special bonus project jointly taught by both Karen & Brian, it's a surprise but we know you are going to love it!

🌸 How do I find out what fabrics I need, and is there a kit available?

You are welcome to bring your own fabrics. Pre-cut kits will be available for purchase with pre-orders being accepted in the Summer of 2020. Fabric requirements, a color key, and pre-cutting instructions will be made available in the Summer of 2020. We will bring your kits onboard for you!

🌸 What about other supplies?

We will be using Studio 180 Design tools and Technique Sheets; these will be available to pre-order, along with the optional fabric kit, if you do not already have them. We will provide you with a complete supply list of items to bring, a list of what is prohibited, as well as a list of items that can be pre-order/purchased and brought onboard for your sewing needs no later than 90 days prior to departure. As experienced cruisers we've got you covered!

🌸 How do I book and reserve my cruise stateroom? Are triple occupancy rooms available? What about upgrades? What documents do I need? Do you book flights, transportation and hotel arrangements? What about Travel Insurance? How do I book Shore Excursions?

Step two of our registration! 🌸 What if I need a roommate?

While we don't guarantee, we will do our best to match you up with a compatible quilting roomie ~ giving you the opportunity to "meet" via email/phone connections prior to our departure. If you don't have a roommate now, or they aren't ready to make a deposit, don't let that stop you from registering! Many quilters have met lifelong friends after sharing a cruise stateroom.

🌸 What if I need to cancel? Can I get a refund? And if so, what is the deadline?

Sometimes life gets in the way and you just can't make it. In the unlikelihood you need to cancel before 06/30/2020 you'll receive a full refund on the Onboard Quilting Excursion™, minus the \$100 deposit. If you cancel anytime between 07/01/2020 and 09/30/2020, you'll receive up to a \$150 refund. We will be unable to offer any refunds after 10/01/2020.

Cancellations with Royal Caribbean are handled through our travel agent Patti and are subject to the Cruise Line's policies. Patti will be able to inform you of these deadlines once you have registered.

🌸 When is the final payment needed?

For both (1) the Onboard Quilting Excursion!™ and (2) the stateroom reservation, final payment is due 5/30/2020. Payment plans are available for each.

🌸 What else do I need to know?

Remember, registration is a two-step process: 1) Onboard Quilting Excursion™ Reservation and 2) Stateroom Reservation. Once you are registered, you'll be sent additional info about signing up for an exclusive newsletter subscription to keep you updated regularly with group communications and valuable information until it's time to quilt & cruise!
